

Windows 8


- 1. Press the **Windows** button and the **X** key (or open the **Control Panel**).

- 1. Right click on the desktop and select NVIDIA Control Panel.
- 2. Expand **3D Settings**.
- 3. Click on Manage 3D settings.
- 4. On the **Global Settings** tab, select **High-performance NVIDIA** processor from the drop-down list:



For AMD

- 1. Open the AMD Catalyst Control Center.
- 2. On the **Performance** page, check or change the **3D Performance** settings.
